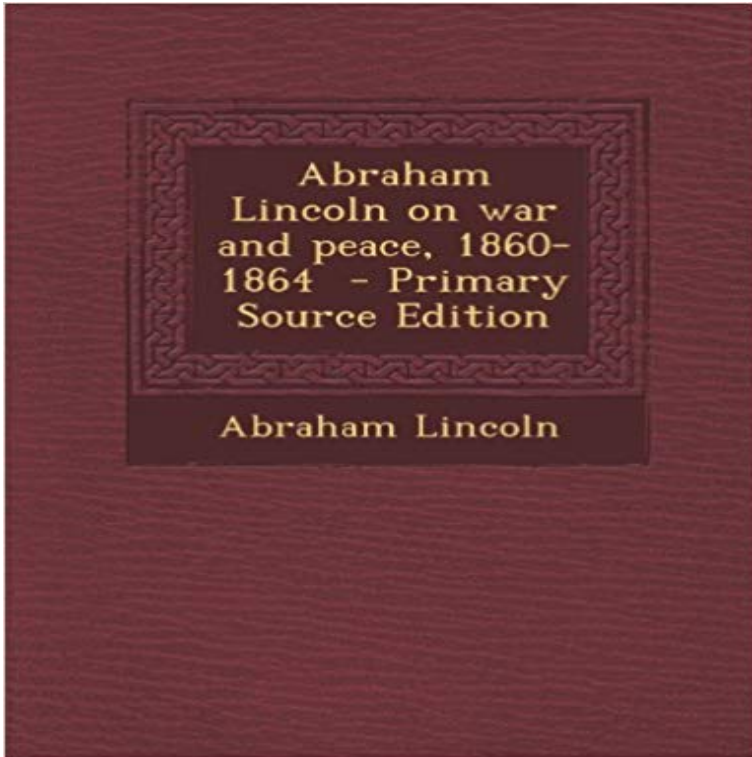


Abraham Lincoln on War and Peace, 1860-1864 - Primary Source Edition
