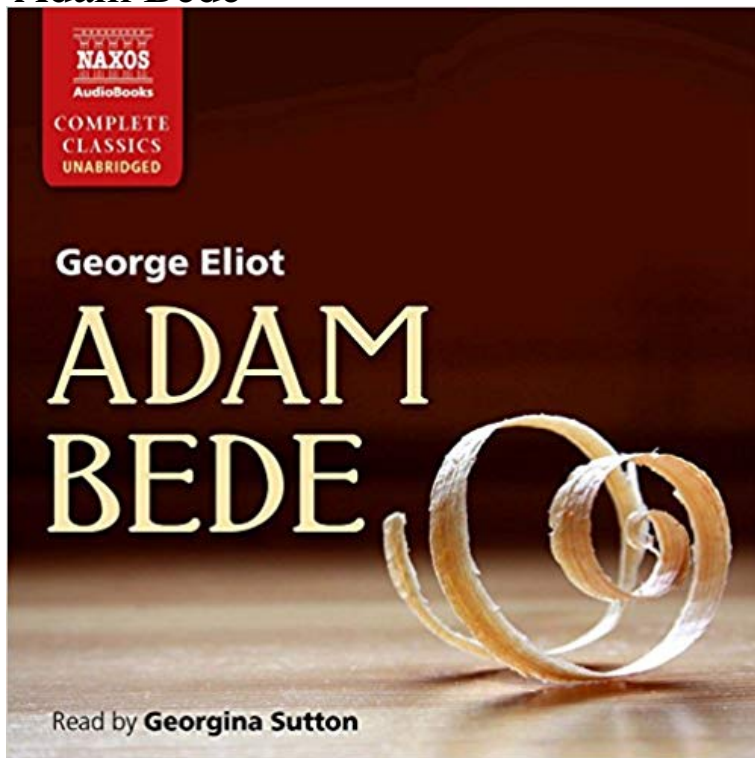


Adam Bede
