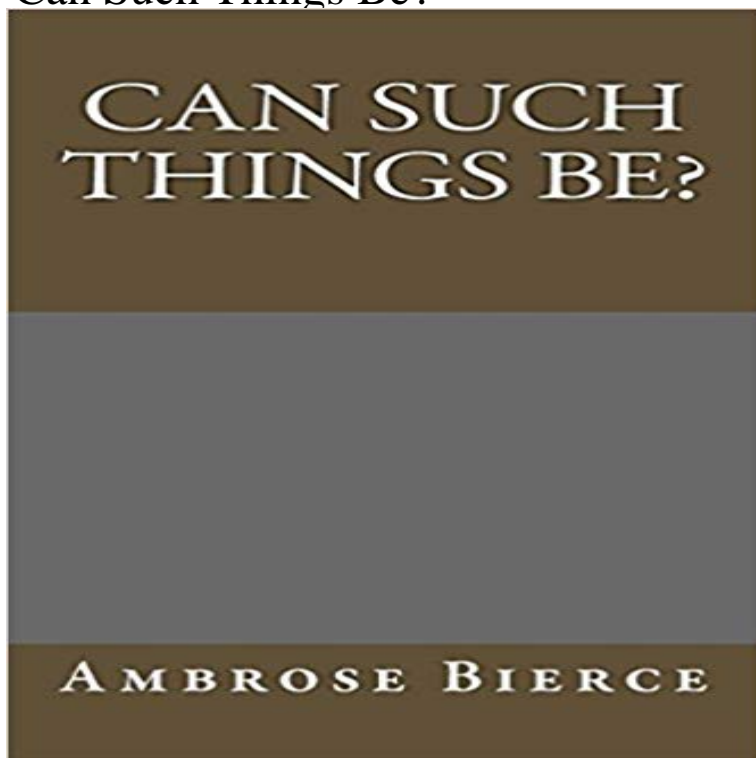


## Can Such Things Be?
