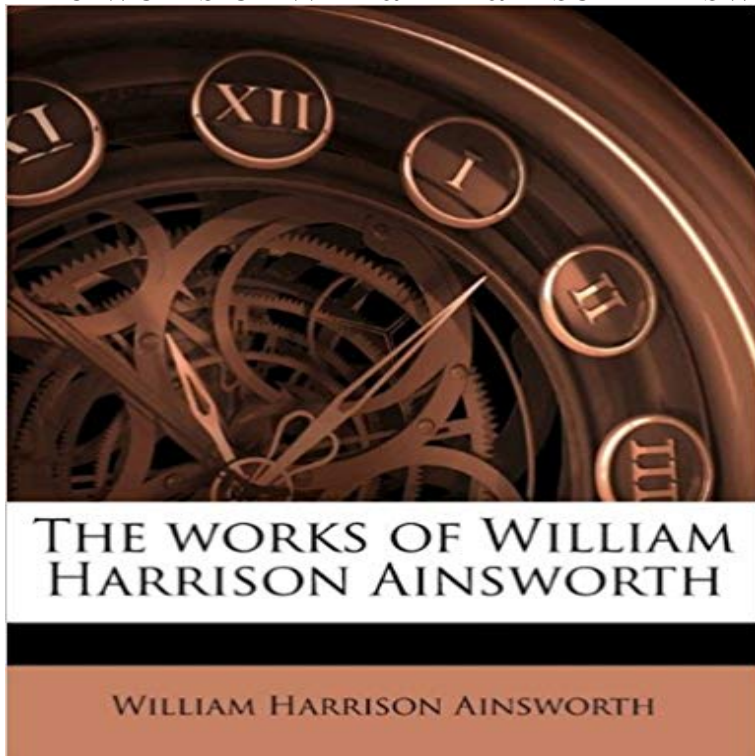


## The works of William Harrison Ainsworth
