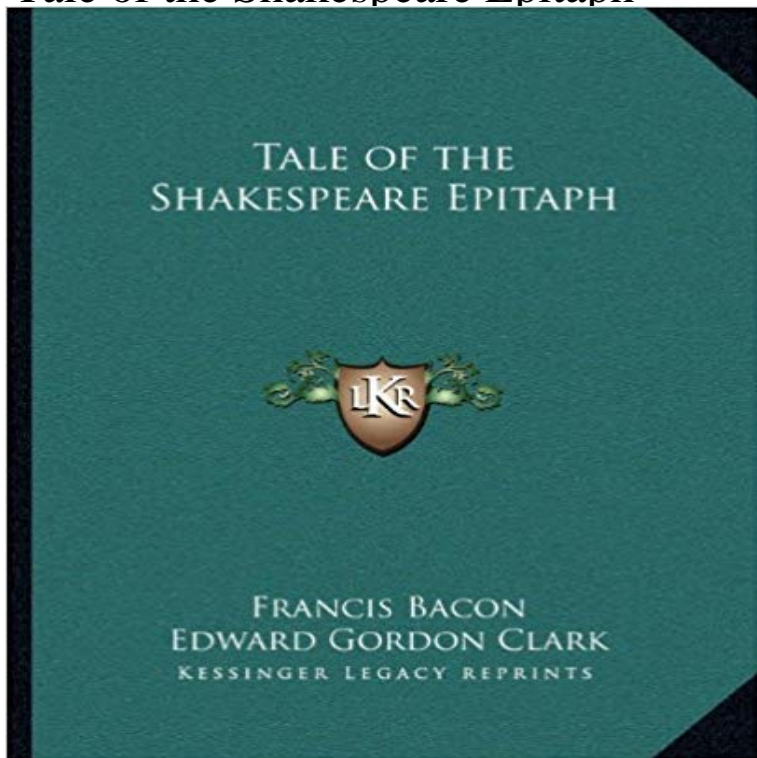


# Tale of the Shakespeare Epitaph
