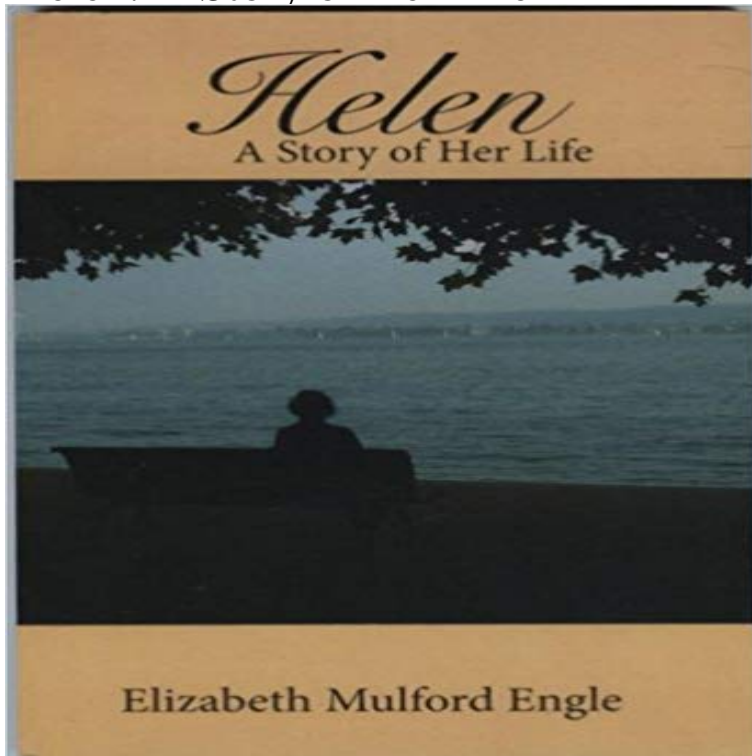


Helen: A Story of Her Life
