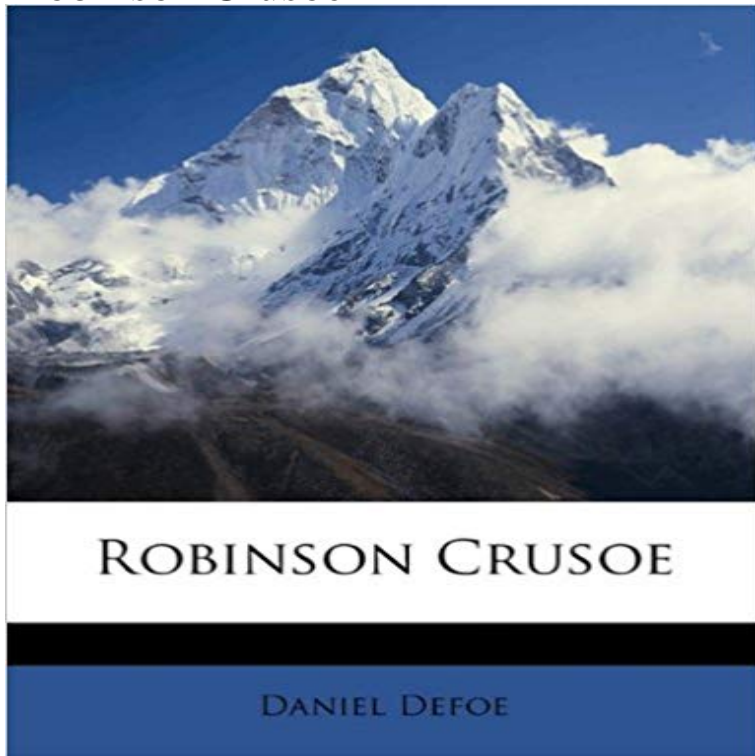


Robinson Crusoe
