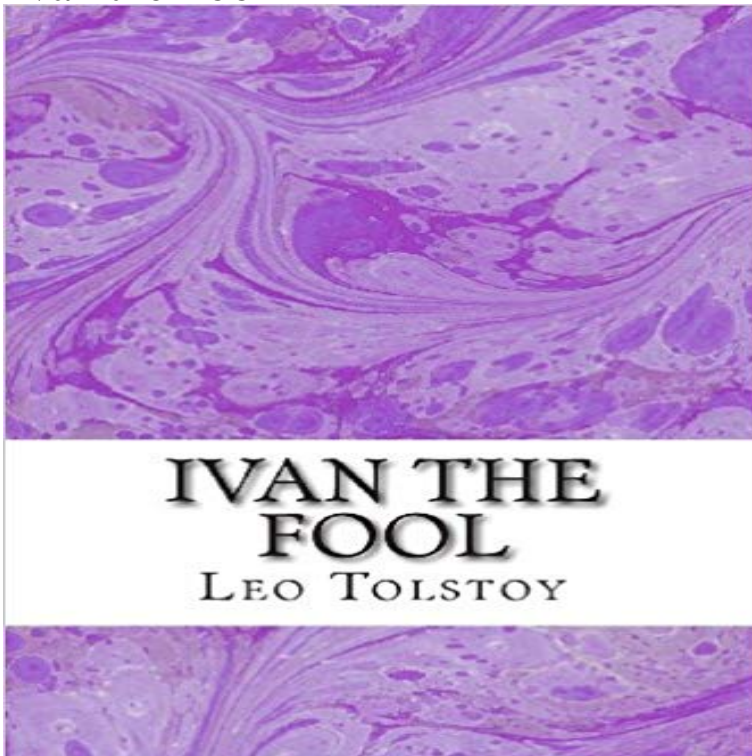


Ivan the Fool
