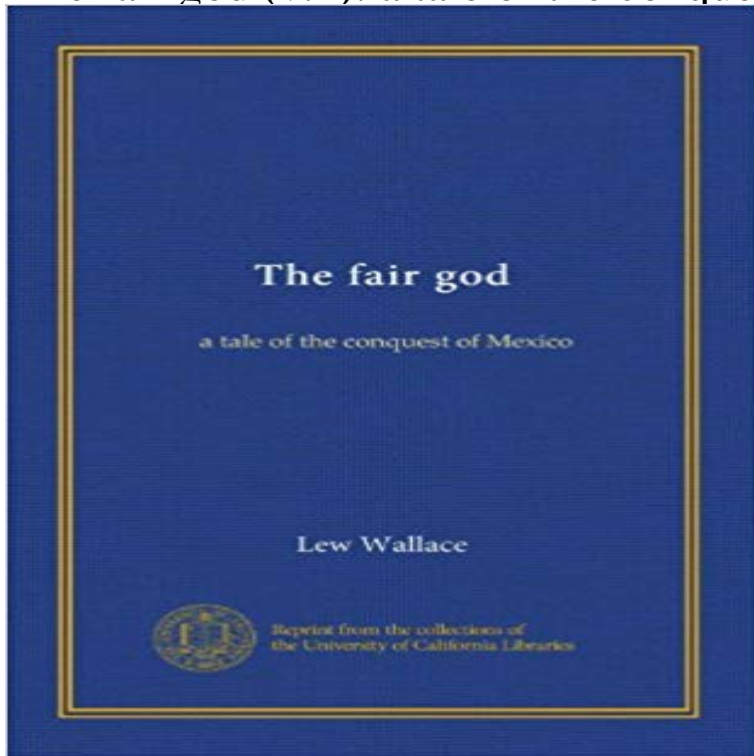


The fair god (v.2): a tale of the conquest of Mexico
