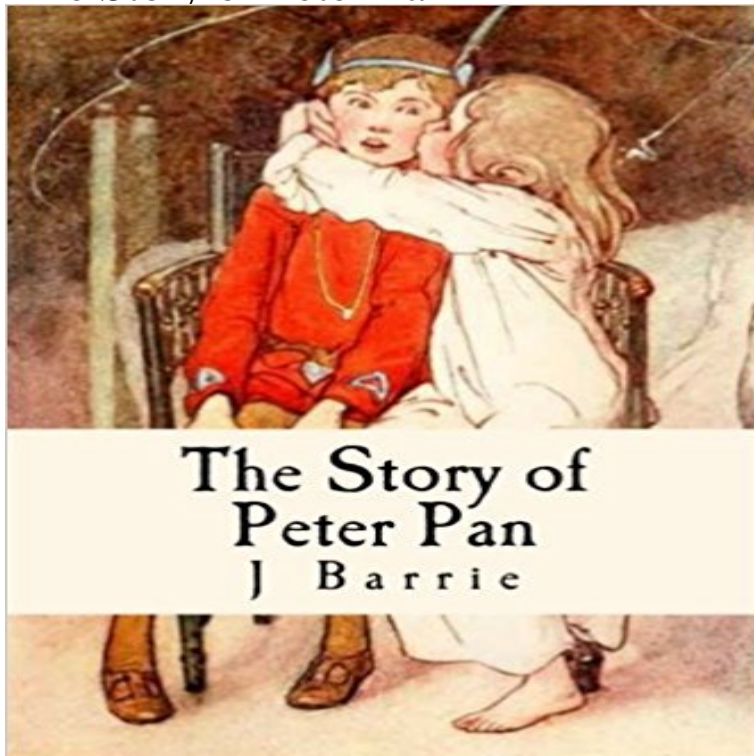


The Story of Peter Pan
