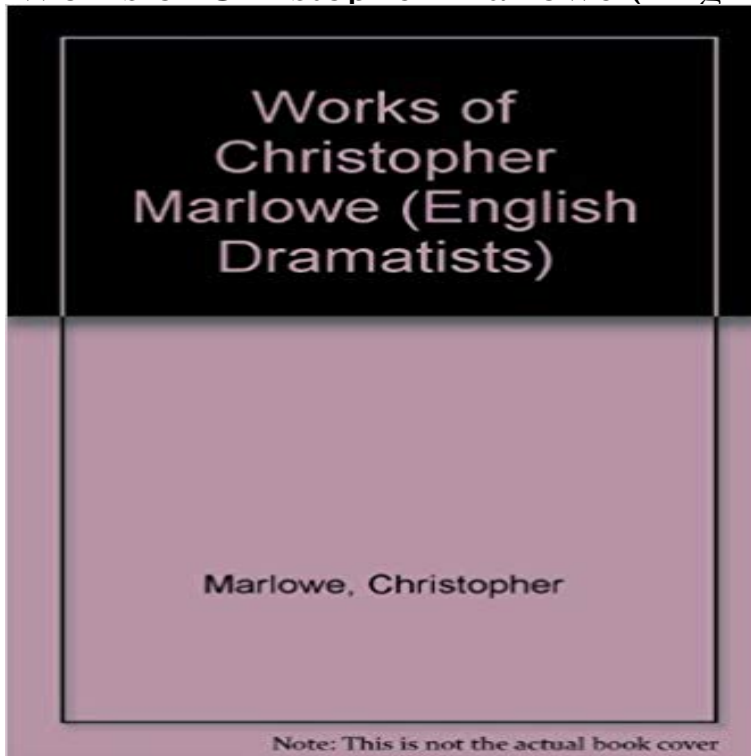


## Works of Christopher Marlowe (English Dramatists)
