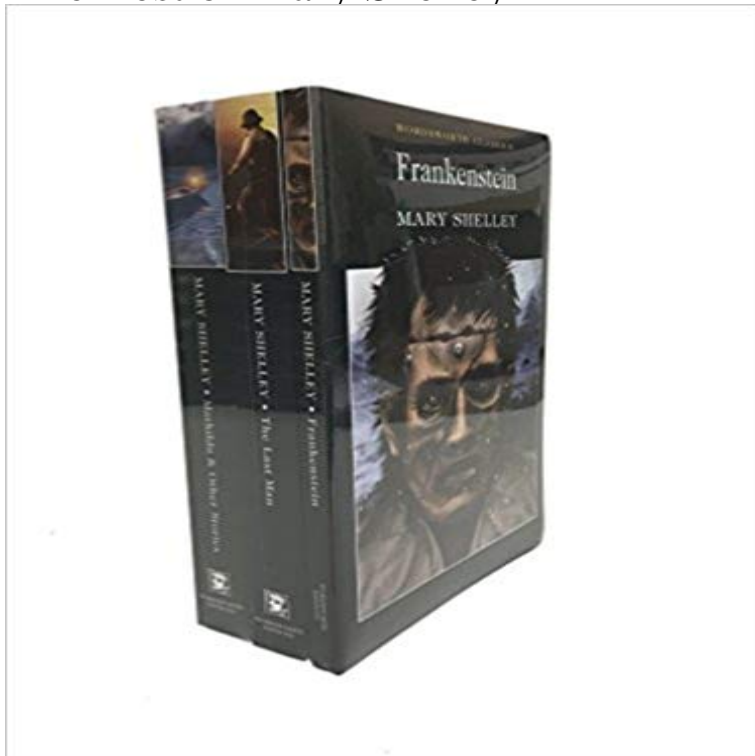


The Best of Mary Shelley
