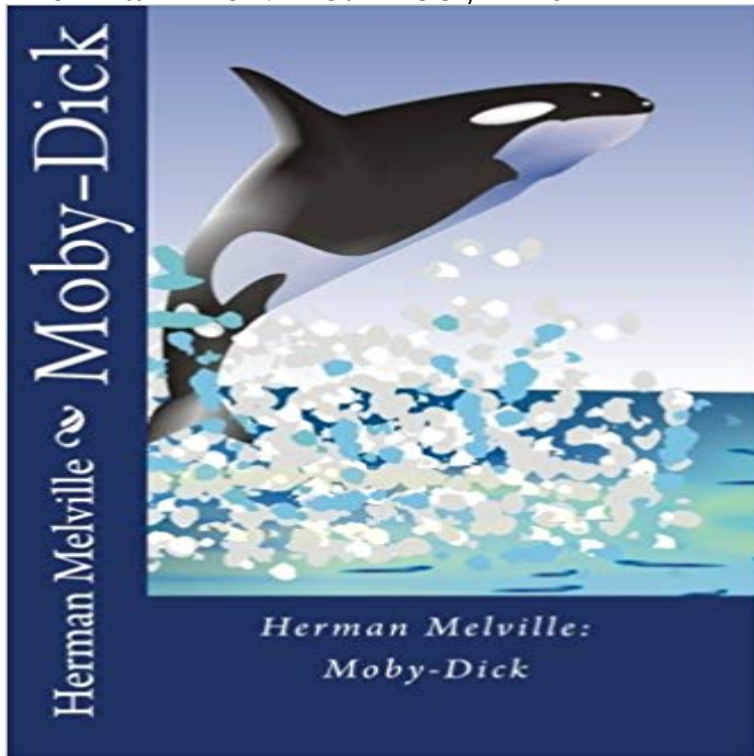


Herman Melville: Moby-Dick
