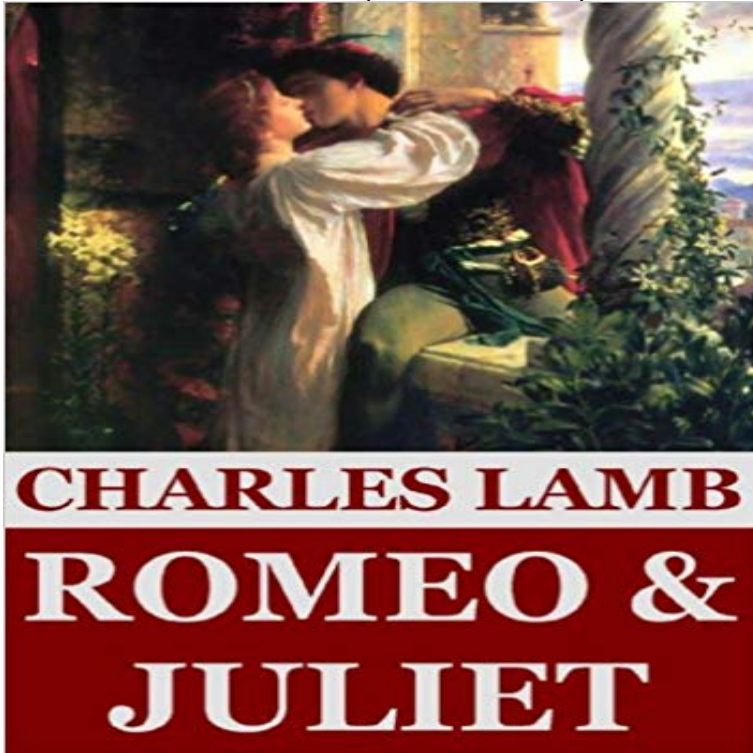


Romeo and Juliet (Annotated)
