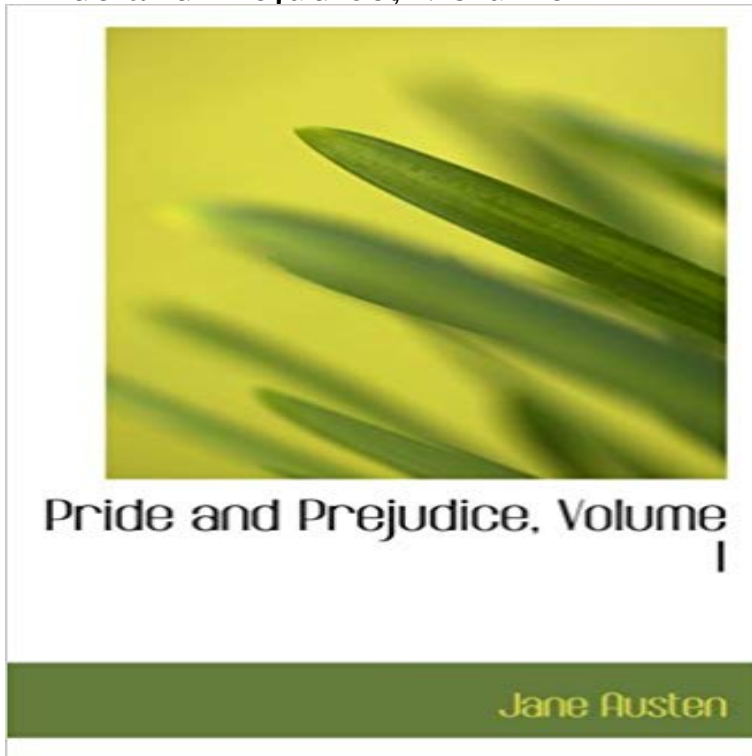


Pride and Prejudice, Volume I
