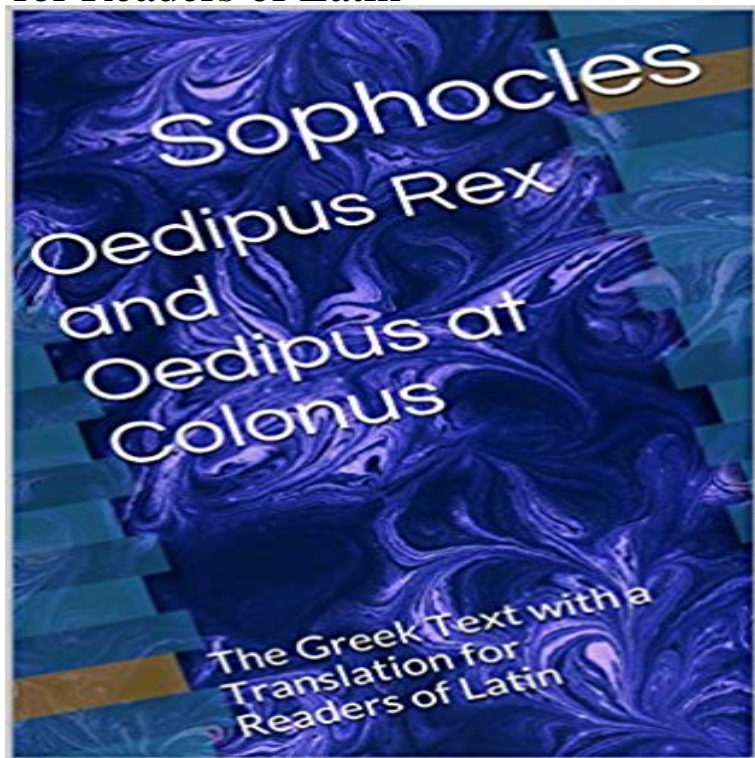


Oedipus Rex and Oedipus at Colonus: The Greek Text with a Translation for Readers of Latin
