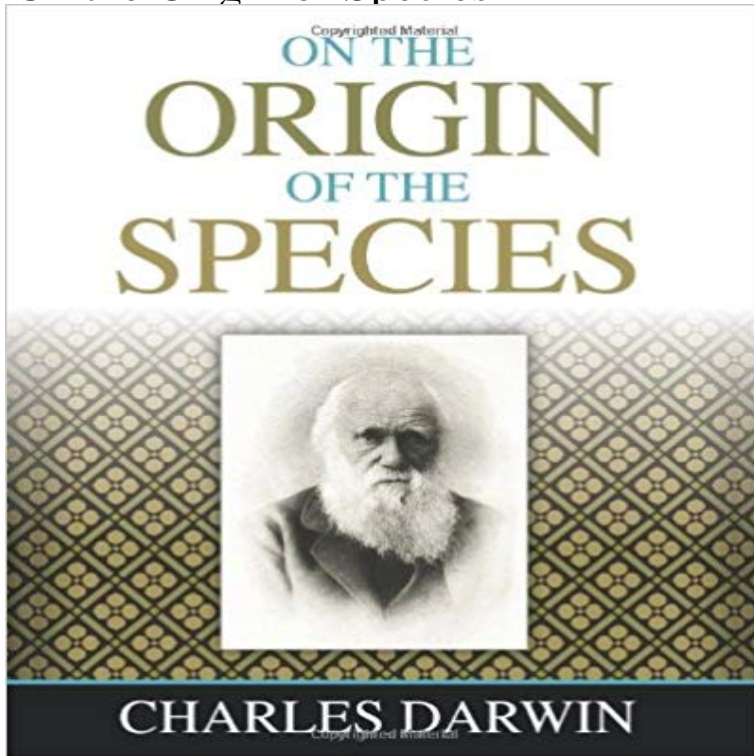


On the Origin of Species
