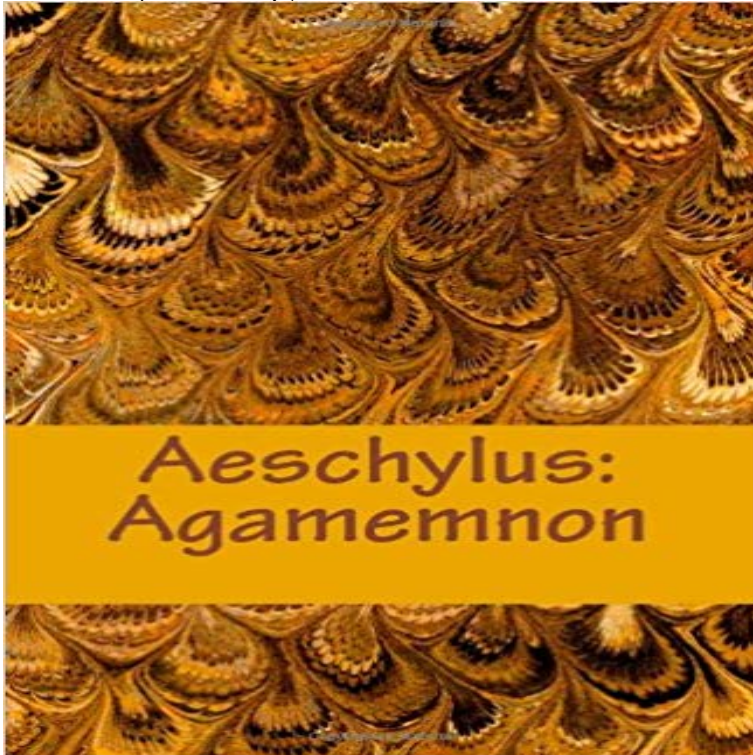


Aeschylus: Agamemnon
