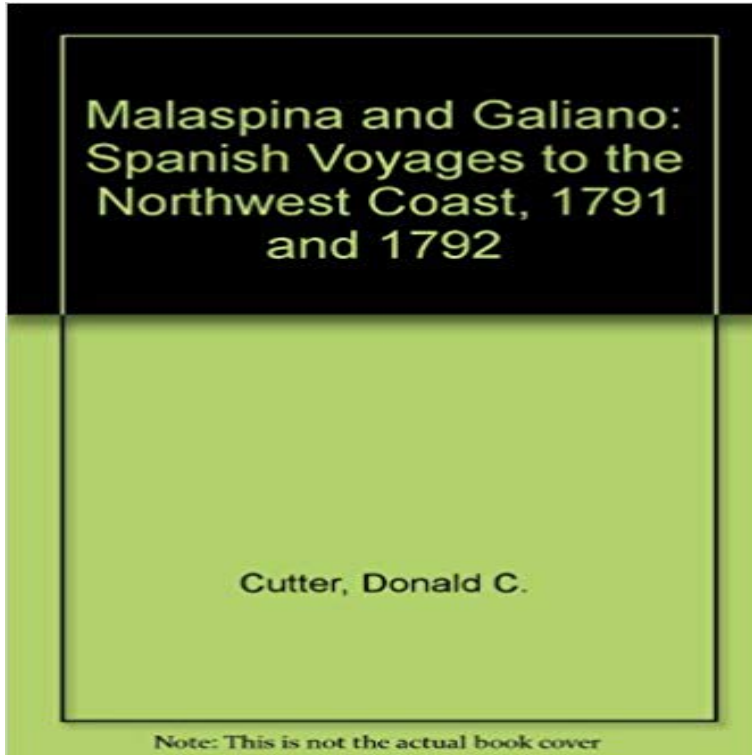


# Malaspina and Galiano: Spanish Voyages to the Northwest Coast, 1791 and 1792
