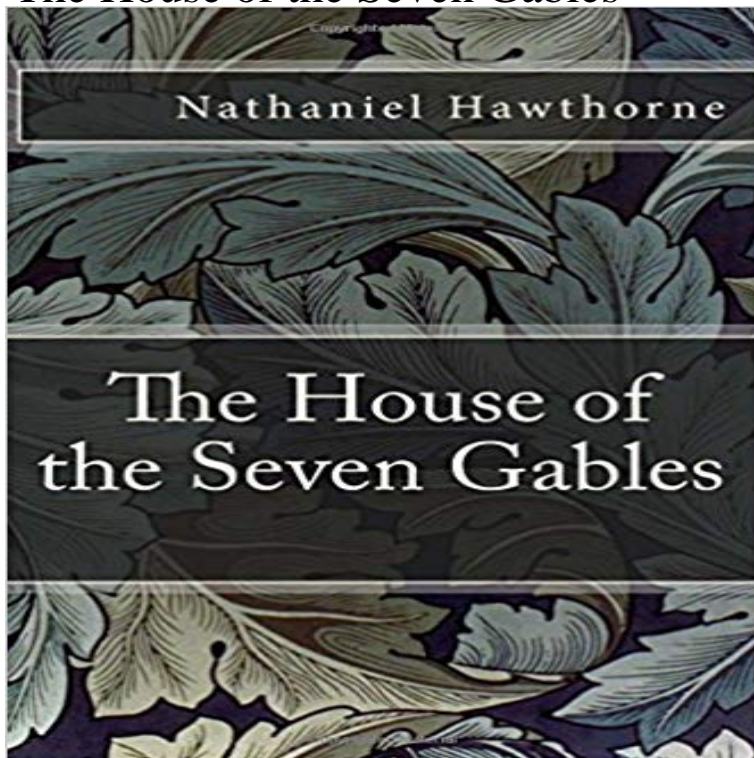


## The House of the Seven Gables



In 1851, following the huge success of his earlier novel, *The Scarlet Letter*, American author, Nathaniel Hawthorne published the Gothic romance, *The House of the Seven Gables*. The inspiration for the book came from a house in Salem Massachusetts, that was owned by his ancestors who had been involved in the famous witch trials of 1692. In writing the novel, Hawthorne expressed concern that he had more difficulty than he did with his earlier work, though when it was finally released it was a huge success. In reflection, Hawthorne said, It sold finely and seems to have pleased a good many people. Prior to its release, his wife Sophia told her mother that he had read her the ending and she expressed that there is unspeakable grace and beauty in the conclusion, throwing back upon the sterner tragedy of the commencement an ethereal light, and a dear home-loveliness and satisfaction. The book had a strong influence on the work of H. P. Lovecraft and has been adapted several times to film and television.
