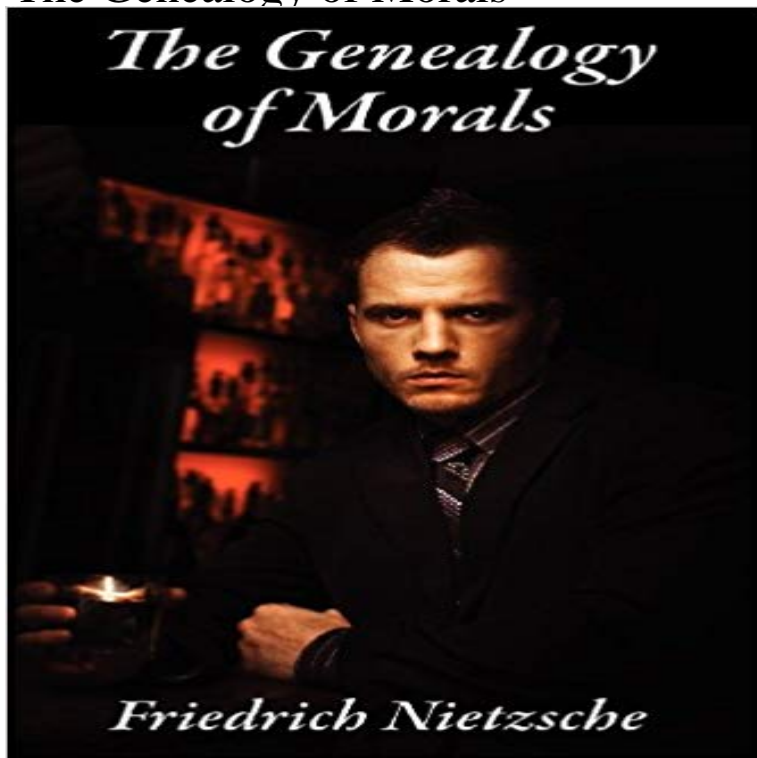


# The Genealogy of Morals
