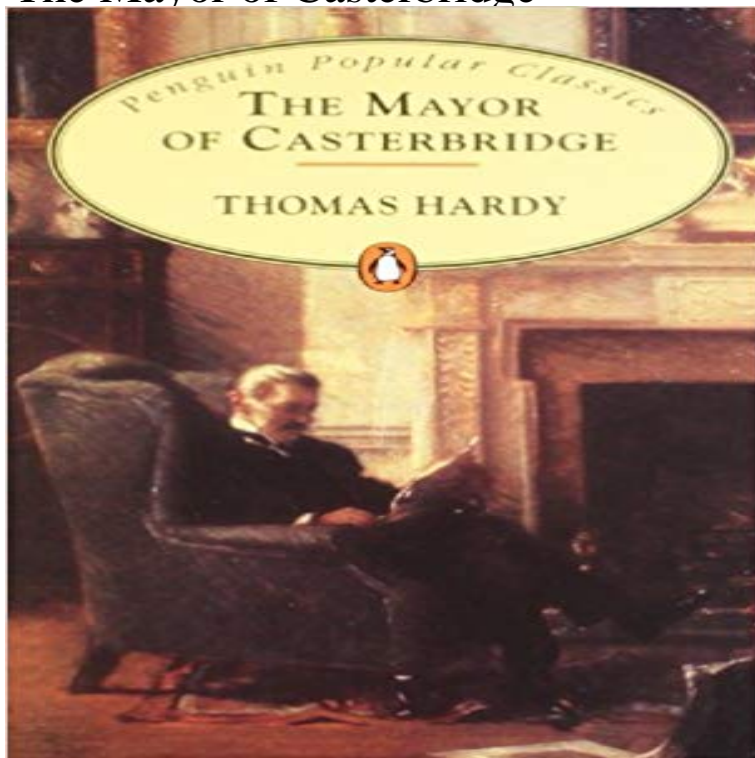


## The Mayor of Casterbridge
