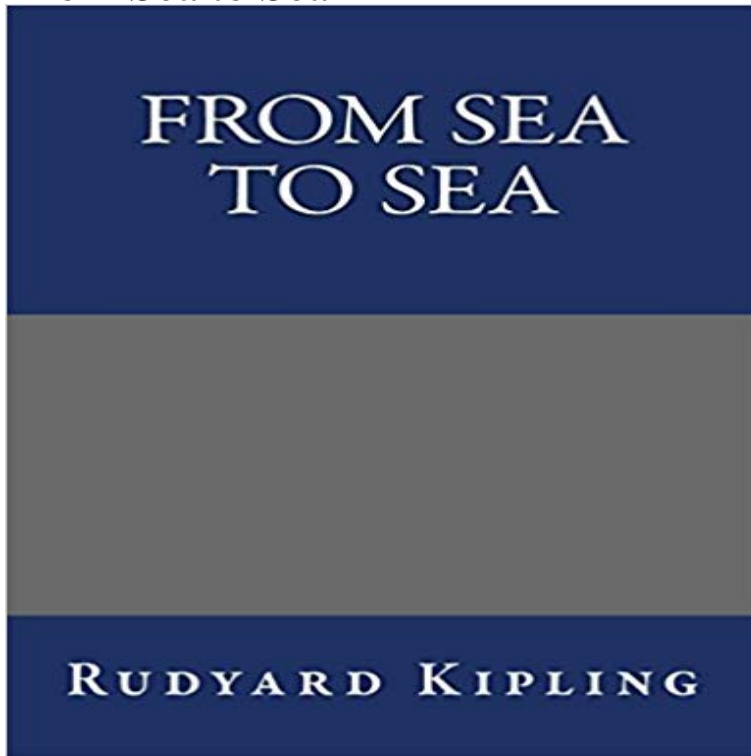


From Sea to Sea
