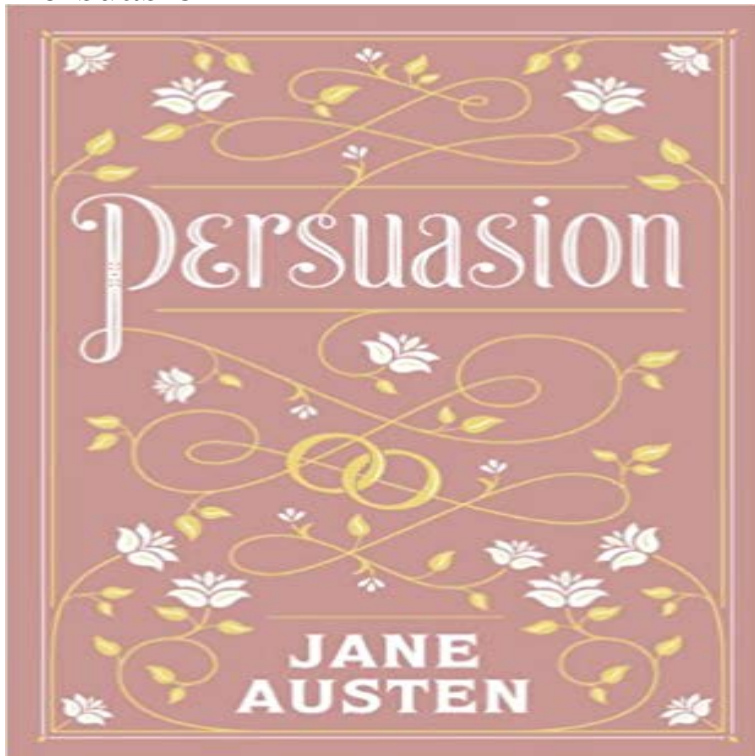


Persuasion
