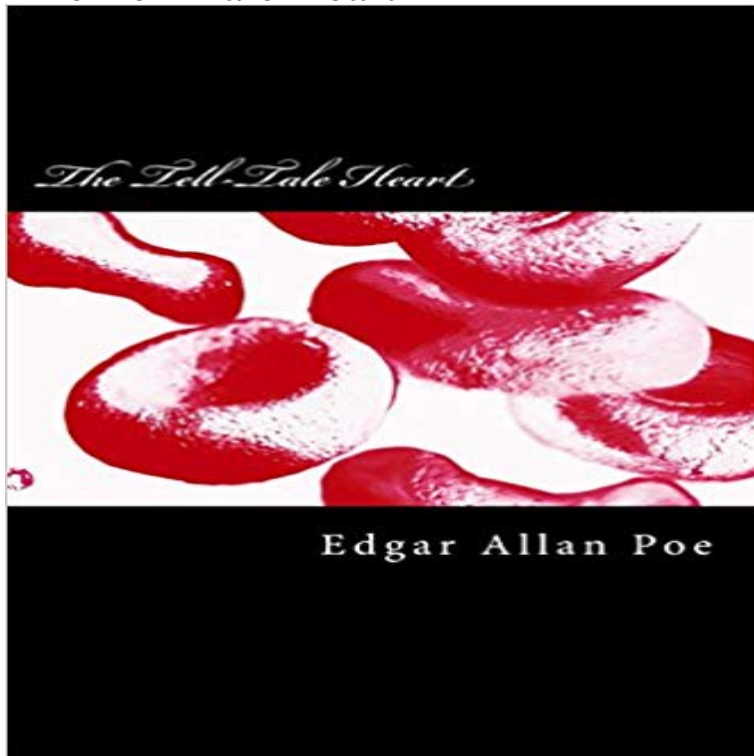


The Tell-Tale Heart
