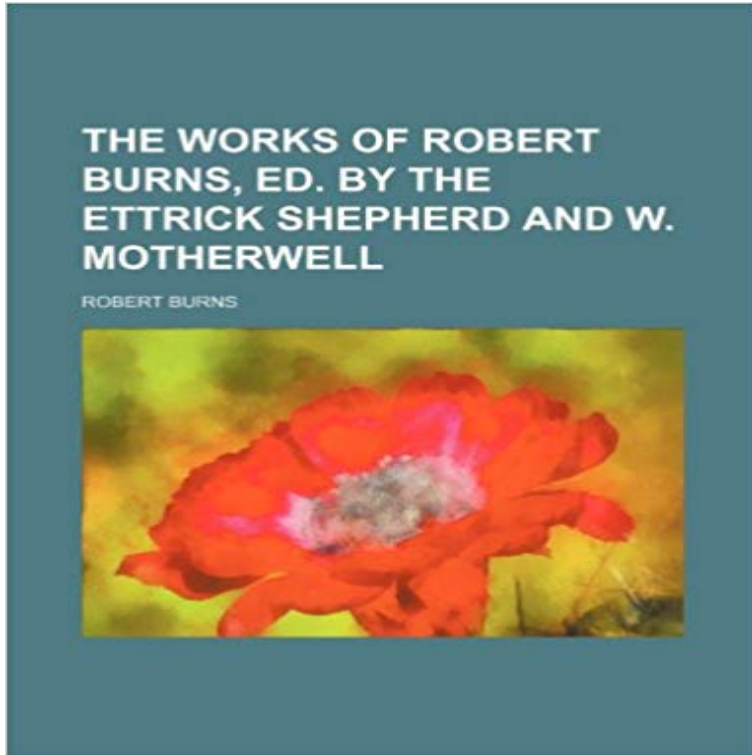

Now that my first sentence is concluded, I have nothing to do but to pray heaven to help me on to another. Shall I write you on politics or religion, two master subjects for your sayers of nothing. Of the first I dare say by this time you are nearly surfeited-. and for the last, whatever they may talk of it, who make it a kind of company concern, I never could endure it beyond a soliloquy. I might write you on farming on building, on marketing, but my poor distracted mind is I so torn, so jaded, so racked and bedeviled with the task of the superlatively damned to make one guinea do the business of three, that I detest, abhor, and swoon at the very word business, though no less than four letters of my very short sirname are in it. Well, to make the matter short, I shall betake myself to a subject ever fruitful of

themes; a subject the turtle feast of the sons  
of Satan, and the delicious secret...
