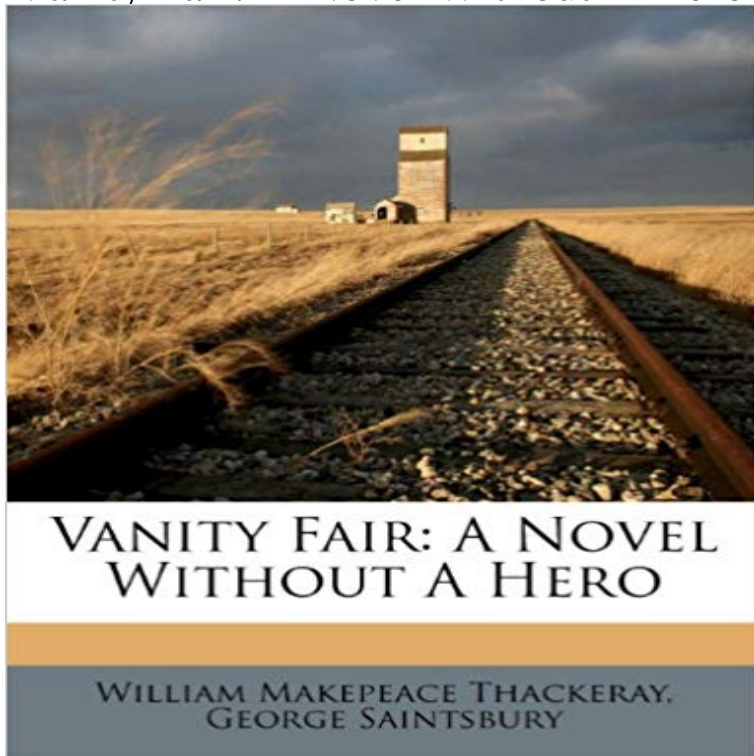


## Vanity Fair: A Novel Without A Hero
